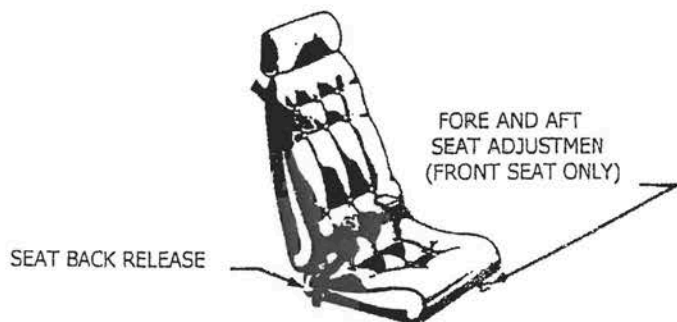
### SEAT BACKS

#### TAKE-OFF & LANDING

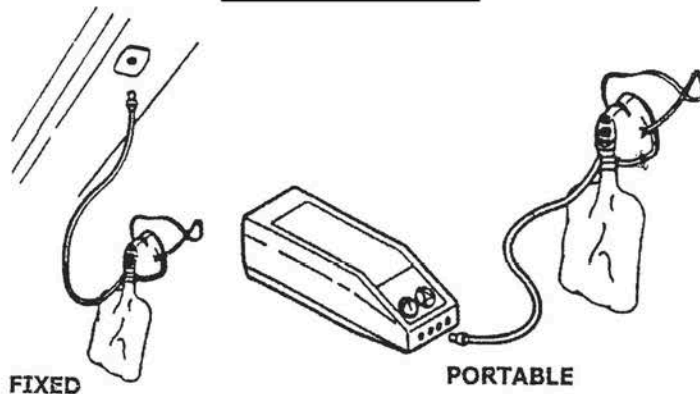
Seat Back In Full

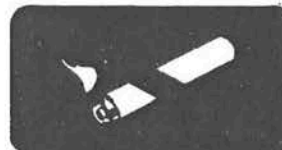
### USE OF OXYGEN



To use oxygen, insert fitting into receptacle. (twist to lock) and don mask.

### CAUTION

"NO SMOKING" while oxygen is in use. Remove oil and grease (including lipstick, chap stick, make-up etc.) before using oxygen.

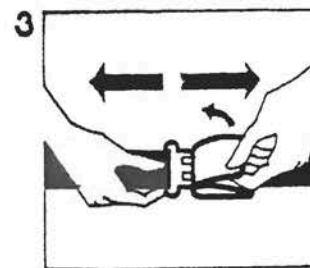
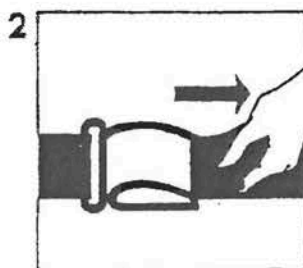
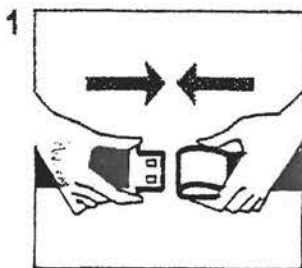


### NO SMOKING AND FASTEN SEAT BELTS

Do not smoke during takeoff or landing or when oxygen is in use.

Fasten seat belt and shoulder harness (if present) for takeoff & landing. Insert latch into buckle & pull belt snug.

To release belt, pull up on raised lip of buckle.

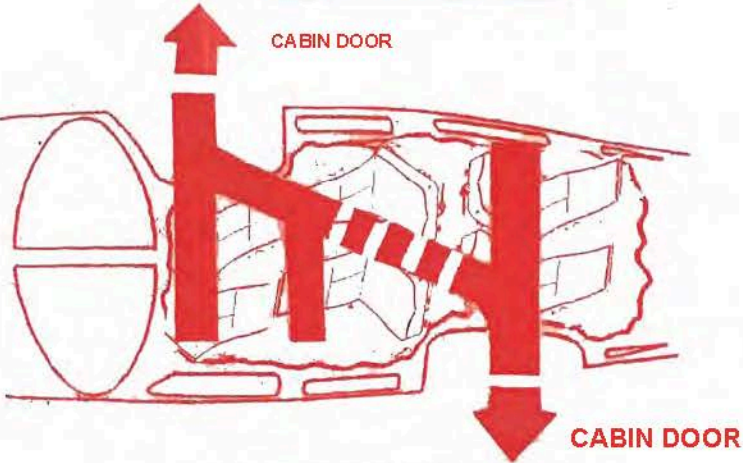

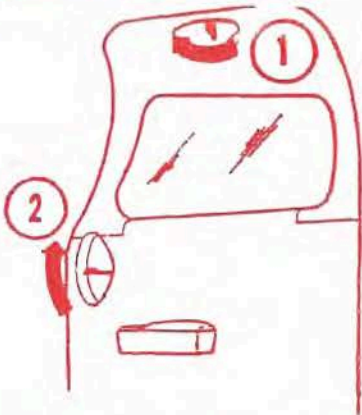

### EMERGENCY EXITS

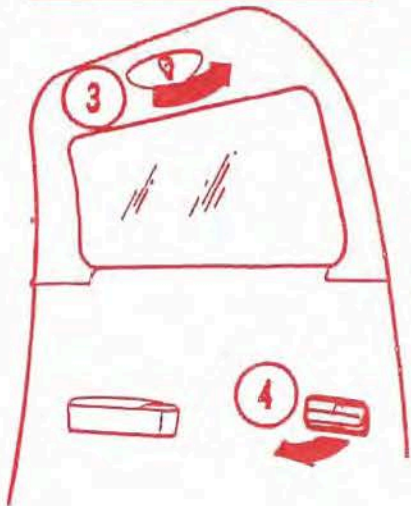


### MAIN CABIN DOOR OPERATIONS



To open cabin door twist upper door latch (1) forward. Pull the lower latch (2). Push door open.

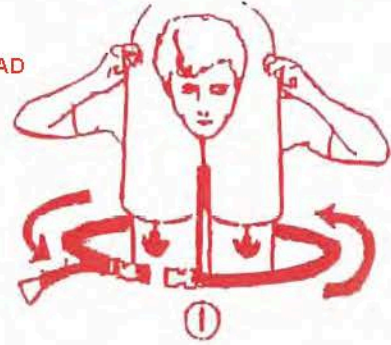
### AFT CABIN DOOR OPERATION



To open aft cabin door, twist upper door latch (3) forward. Pull lower door latch (4) out. Push door open.

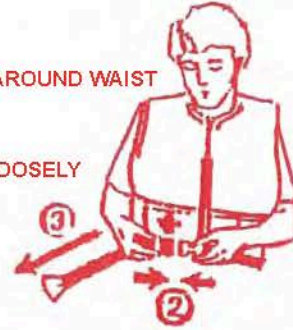
### FLOTATION

1. PLACE VEST OVER HEAD



2. CONNECT STRAP AROUND WAIST

3. TIGHTEN STRAP LOOSELY AROUND WAIST



4. AFTER LEAVING AIRCRAFT, JERK RED TABS TO INFLATE JACKET



5. BLOW INTO TUBES IF JACKET IS NOT FULLY INFLATED



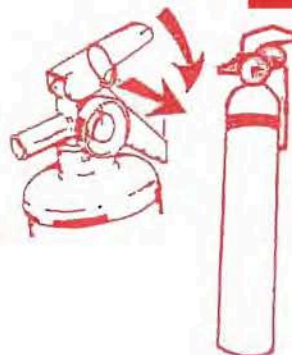
6. PULL PLUGS ON BLUE BATTERY PACK TO WATER ACTIVATE LIGHT

### BRACE POSITIONS



### FIRE EXTINGUISHER

LOCATION WILL BE ANNOUNCED BY THE FLIGHT CREW.



To Operate: Hold up right. Pull pin. Press lever handle. Discharge at base of flame with side to side motion.
